



# Visitor Fact Sheet

# Arranging a Visit

- ✓ Visits may be subject to the core principles of infection prevention.
- ✓ Visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 upon arrival. If they fail the screening, the visit will be rescheduled.
- √ Visitors must notify The Lodge, if they develop COVID-19 symptoms within two days of their visit.
- ✓ Current iInfection control protocols and policies will be observed.

#### **Outdoor Visitaton**

✓ Outdoor visitation is preferred. Outdoor visits generally pose a lower risk of transmission due to increased space and airflow. Therefore, visits should be held outdoors whenever practical.

### **Indoor Visitation**

- √ Indoor visitation may be limited or suspended depending upon the active case status in the community or facility.
- Indoor visitation will occur in common areas that limit visitor movement through resident care areas.
- ✓ In-room visits can be arranged.

## **Visitation Expectations**

- ✓ Social distancing of minimum of six feet is required.
- ✓ Gifts and personal items can be exchanged at visit.
- ✓ Masks/face coverings or other required PPE **must** be worn throughout the entire visit.
- ✓ Eating or drinking is allowed during the visit as long as social distancing can occur.
- ✓ Hand sanitizing and/or hygiene should be done upon arrival and upon end of the visit.
- ✓ Visitors who are unable to adhere to the core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention should not be permitted to visit or should be asked to leave.
